The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of the Netherlands presents its compliments to and has the honour to inform as follows.

The Ministry has been requested by the police to inform of an incident that took place in The Hague at approximately on 2013, involving Mr (born on). Mr employed by and has status.

Mr -was driving his car in a manner that attracted the attention of the police. A breath test revealed that he was driving under the influence of alcohol. The test showed a breath alcohol level of 460 µg/l. The statutory maximum for driving a vehicle is 220 µg/l. Mr was taken home by the police.

Normally, driving behaviour of this kind leads to immediate arrest. However, the police did not proceed as usual because of Mr status. Under the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, it is the duty of all persons enjoying such privileges and immunities to respect the laws and regulations of the receiving State. Driving under the influence of alcohol is an offence under Dutch law.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the assurances of its highest consideration.
